Re: Illegal Parking on Alley Behind 700 Block of C St. SE

Dear Director Kershbaum and Director Spriggs:

At a properly noticed general meeting on April 8, 2024, with a quorum present, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6B voted 6-0-0, based on the unanimous recommendation of its Transportation Committee, to submit the following request to the Department of Transportation (DDOT) and Department of Public Works (DPW).

We write about illegal parking in and just outside the alley between 7th and 8th Streets, SE, just north of C Street, SE. Illegally parked cars, both in the alley and just outside on 7th and 8th St., frequently block residents who require unimpeded access to the alley to get to the road where all have garages and/or parking aprons. Since the north end of the alley is shaped oddly, it's very difficult to enter the central part of the alley from that side, particularly from 7th St. Often, trucks parked on 7th or 8th St. block the entry point to the alley or (more frequently) individuals parking in the alley itself make it difficult to pass through or turn into the middle.

ANC 6B urges DDOT to install additional signs to make clear that the alley is off limits to non-resident parking. Additionally, ANC 6B urges DPW to conduct additional parking enforcement in the area.

Thank you in advance for considering and granting great weight to our recommendations. We look forward to your response.
