4. Updates / Informational Items

A. Aloha – Status Update

The Committee reviewed the second application of **Aloha**, a medical cannabis retailer with a Delivery Endorsement request.

The motion to **negotiate and approve the agreement points** drafted during the emergency meeting and subsequent discussions **passed 9-1-0**.

Approved Points:

- 1. No cannabis or tobacco advertising in the alley between 7th and 8th Streets SE.
- 2. Two employees on-site at all times; one trained security stationed at the entrance; exterior monitoring during school overlap.
- 3. Security will discourage smoking in front or in the alley whenever observed or reported.
- 4. No public entrance/exit to the alley; staff/emergency use only.
- 5. Manager contact number to be provided to ANC.
- 6. Camera footage retained for 30 days and shared with MPD upon request.
- 7. No advertising with people, characters, or caricatures smoking cannabis; removal of cartoon smoking characters and neon bong.
- 8. Compliance with the submitted security plan.

Additional Action:

The Committee voted **10-0-0**, unanimous, to **draft a request to the DC Council** to clarify inconsistencies in regulations relating to schools/daycares and cannabis/alcohol licensure. This item was **placed on consent**.

B. Ambar – Status Update

Ambar's matter remains in negotiation. No vote was taken.

5. Barracks Row Round Table - Proposed Roster & Scope

The Committee continued discussion of the Barracks Row roundtable concept, including:

- Reviewing participating establishments
- Outlining initial goals
