



ANC 6B Resolution to Name 6B09 Alley “Matthews Court”

At its regularly scheduled, properly noticed meeting on June 9, with a quorum present, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6B voted unanimously to support this resolution supporting the naming of an unnamed alley accessed on the 1400 block of G St SE.

WHEREAS, the alley accessed on the north side of the 1400 block of G St SE is currently unnamed.

WHEREAS, naming the designated alley “Matthews Court” would provide a fitting, place-based tribute to the multigenerational DC native Matthews family.

WHEREAS, the Matthews family has been a part of the DC community for generations, and members of the Matthews family helped build the infrastructure that made Washington, DC what it is today.

WHEREAS, the designated alley contains only one address, currently owned by Kelly Matthews, and her home is adorned with a large mural dedicated to the Matthews family featuring the DC statehood slogan “No Taxation Without Representation.”

Therefore be it resolved that:

- ANC 6B supports action by the Council of the District of Columbia to rename the alley on the 1400 block of G Street SE “Matthews Court.”
