**RESOLUTION REQUESTING EVALUATION OF POTENTIAL HEALTH EFFECTS OF RADIO FREQUENCY RADIATION, AND FOR A MEANS FOR ANCS TO PROVIDE INPUT ON INSTALLATIONS OF CONCERN**

**WHEREAS**, DC Department of Transportation (DDOT) Public Space Committee has unilaterally adopted Guidelines without consulting with the DC Health (DoH) and the Department of Energy & Environment (DOEE) to allow the installation of nearly 7,000 small cell towers across the city,

**WHEREAS**, the Guidelines provide no means of ANCs to flag proposed installations which may have an adverse impact on the neighborhood,

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that ANC 6B requests that DOH and DOEE study the potential health effects of radio frequencies emitted by 5G Small Cell towers, and.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that DDOT's Public Space Commission provide a means for ANCs to provide input on specific proposed installations that may have an adverse impact on the neighborhood.
