



**ANC6B Transportation Committee Meeting Memo
October 7, 2020**

Commissioners present: Corey Holman, Steve Holtzman, Kirsten Oldenburg (chairing), Brian Ready, Jennifer Samolyk, Jerry Sroufe and Kelly Waud

Discussion on Kentucky Bike Lanes Proposal (NOI 20-80-PSD)

Commissioner Oldenburg moved, with a second by Commissioner Holman, to recommend the Commission support DDOT plans to install Advisory bike lanes on Kentucky Avenue SE between East Capitol Street & 15th Street SE, install contraflow and regular bike lanes on Kentucky Ave between G Street & Barney Circle SE, and modify parking to conform to the current DDOT design and engineering manual (DEM) standards as described in NOI 20-80-PSD. Further the Committee asks that DDOT provide the community with the bike lane concepts for the 700 & 800 blocks of Kentucky Avenue SE, if possible, prior to the Commission's meeting on October 13.

The Committee approved the motion unanimously and placed it on the Consent Agenda.

DDOT Request for ANC Support on 6B06 Traffic Safety Assessments

Commissioner Holman moved, with a second by Commissioner Sroufe, to recommend that the Commission support a Traffic Safety Assessment to be submitted to DDOT to request 2 speed humps on the 400 block of 13th Street SE.

Commissioner Holman moved, with a second by Commissioner Holtzman, to recommend that the Commission support a Traffic Safety Assessment to be submitted to DDOT to request two speed humps on the 1300 block of D Street SE and one on the 1400 block of D Street SE; a raised crosswalk at the intersection of 14th & C Streets SE; and an evaluation of converting the 400 block of 14th Street SE to one-way southbound.

The Committee approved both motions unanimously and placed it on the Consent Agenda.

Resolution on Separating Residential Permit Parking from Ward Boundaries

Commissioner Holman moved, with a second by Commissioner Ready, to recommend the Commission support a resolution requesting the DC Council to expeditiously pass legislation separating Residential Permit Parking (RPP) zones from Ward boundaries before Decennial Redistricting occurs by requiring the District Department of Transportation to set RPP zones unrelated to Ward boundaries, just as MPD Districts, Police Service Area, and Office of Planning Planning Areas boundaries are set by criteria unrelated to Wards.

The Committee approved the motion by a vote of 8-0-4 and placed it on the Consent Agenda.

ANC6B October Letter to DDOT on Traffic Safety Assessment Requests

The ANC has not had any response from DDOT on the TSAs included in the October letter. After some discussion about how to proceed, Commissioner Ready, Chair of the Commission, said he would talk with DDOT about the letter before the ANC Monthly meeting on 10/13.

Review of DDOT's Proposed Rulemaking on Revisions to Annual Visitor Parking Pass & Temporary Parking Pass Programs

There was a very brief discussion on this rulemaking as the deadline to end the meeting at 9pm was near. Committee felt there were substantial changes in this proposal and it deserved more discussion and resolution at the Commission's 10/13 meeting.

Draft motion for Commission to consider: ANC6B supports DDOT's Proposed Rulemaking on revisions to the annual VPP and Temporary parking pass programs. However, the Commission is concerned that the flexibility provided to use digital technologies could lead to some residents without internet connections to be disadvantaged.
